PORT LINCOLN LIBRARY TOILET FACILITIES TO CLOSE FOR REFURBISHMENT WORKS

The City of Port Lincoln Council is excited that work is about to start on new toilet facilities at the Port Lincoln Library with works scheduled to start from 9am on Friday 16 March, 2018.

The upgrade to the toilet facilities will include a new unisex/accessible toilet that includes a baby change table, a new designated staff toilet and refurbishment works to the existing male and female toilets. Council, in conjunction with TAFE SA, has gained state Government funding support of \$25,000 for this upgrade. The works is expected to be completed by Friday 20 April 2018.

The existing toilets will be closed to the public, and during this time patrons will have access to the TAFE toilets adjacent to the Library from Monday to Fridays. The Library will be closed on Sunday 18 & 25 March, 1 (Easter Sunday), 8 and 15 April 2018 while the work is being undertaken so that the majority of the demolition works can be carried out over the weekends to minimise the impact to patrons.

Manager Library Services, Louise Mrdjen said “The new toilet facility will be a welcome addition to the Library environment, particularly with the installation of an accessible unisex toilet and baby change table”.

The entrance to the Library on London Street will also be upgraded to an automatic door with \$8,000 funding received by the Department of State Development. These works will be undertaken at the same time as the toilet refurbishment to minimise interruption to the Library service.

Mayor Bruce Green said “The upgrade to the toilet facilities at the Library will make it more inclusive of people with disabilities, carers, and families with young children and the broader community”.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may have on our Library patrons and trust that the upgraded toilet facility when completed will be well worth it.
